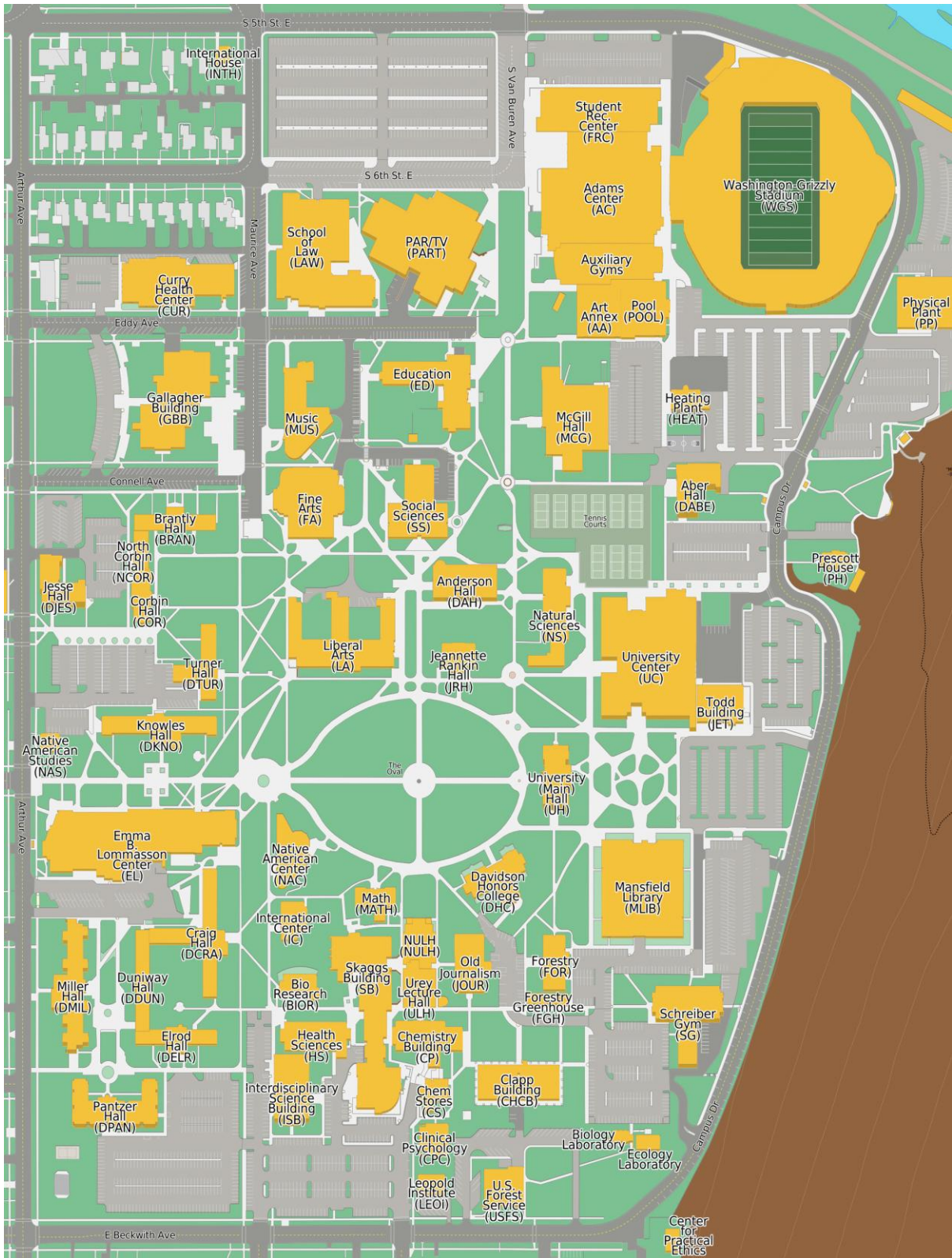
Parking

Buses or vans **seating less than 15 people may park in UM parking lot "U"**, which is at the base of Mount Sentinel (campus parking map enclosed) A **1-day parking pass** may be purchased for **\$3** at the Public Safety Office next to this parking lot (directly across from the stadium). 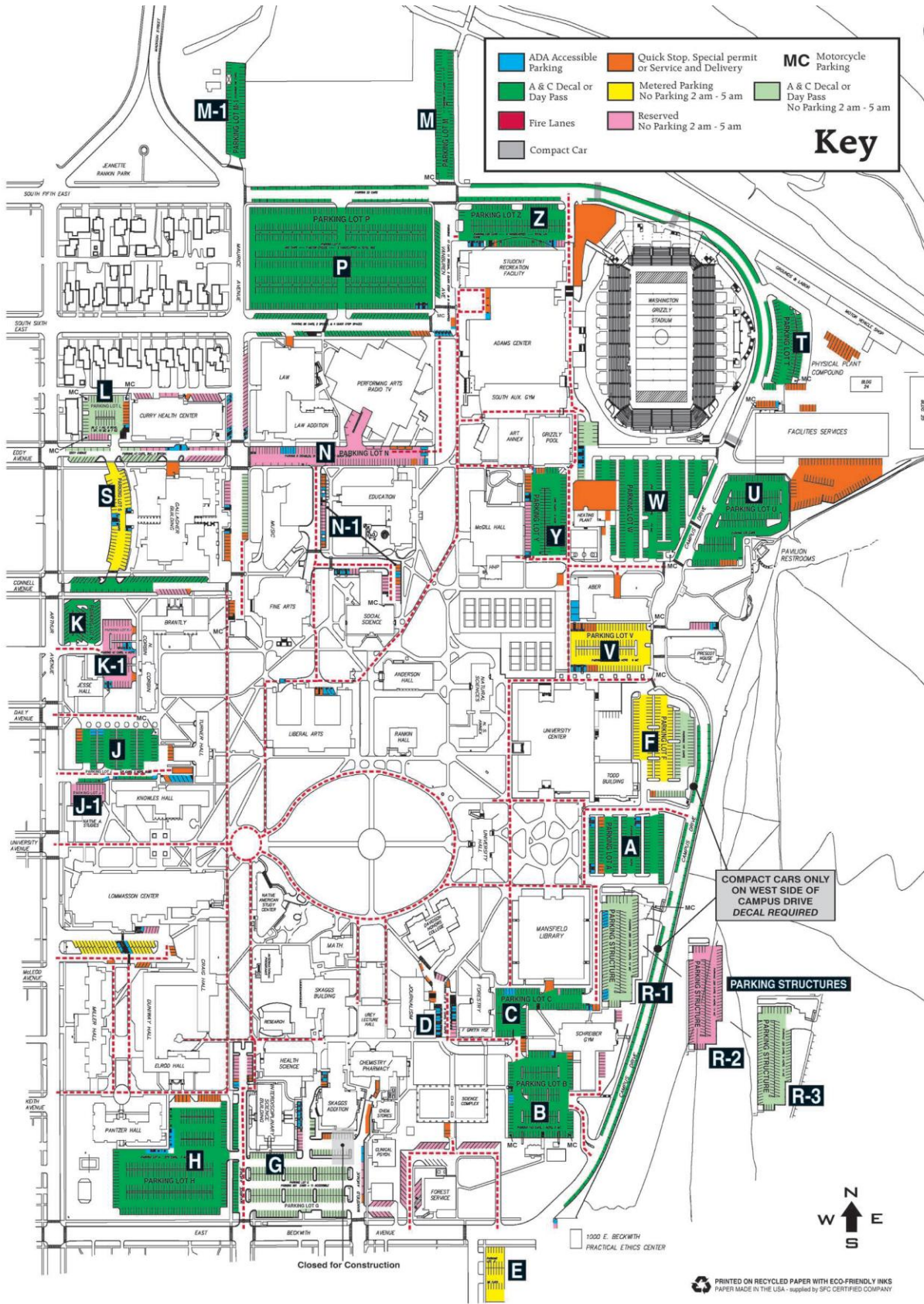
Buses or vans **seating more than 15 people** are asked to park at the East Broadway Park-N-Ride (Park-N-Ride map enclosed). Drivers may drop students off at the University at the bus stop across from Aber Hall on Campus Drive near the UC (marked on campus map). Bus drivers may ride the ASUM Park-N-Ride bus back to the University after parking the bus/van and pick it up again in the evening. Buses run every 10 minutes **until 6:25pm**.
